ACCWPA Apprentice Program Registration for 2021-2022 classes is now open!

Registration Eligibility for 1st and 2nd year classes.

To qualify for 2nd year classes, you will need to test out by August 20th)

ACCWPA's classes will start Sept. 14th

Pittsburgh Technical College (PTC)

This is a four-year program that combines 3200 hours of classroom and lab training with 8,000 hours of On-the-Job Training, (OJT). Upon completion, the successful student will be awarded an ACCWPA Diploma, PA State Journeyman's certificate companies need to apply for each student that has completed the 8000 OJT hours, attain a CFC certification, NATE core/heat pump certification and OSHA10 certification.

First year classes are designed for entry level students who may or may not have some field experience or formal training. Second year students must have either completed the 1st year class OR if you have an employee who has entry level experience and training but needs more training and help to advance, you can have them "test out" of the first year and start in the 2nd year.
